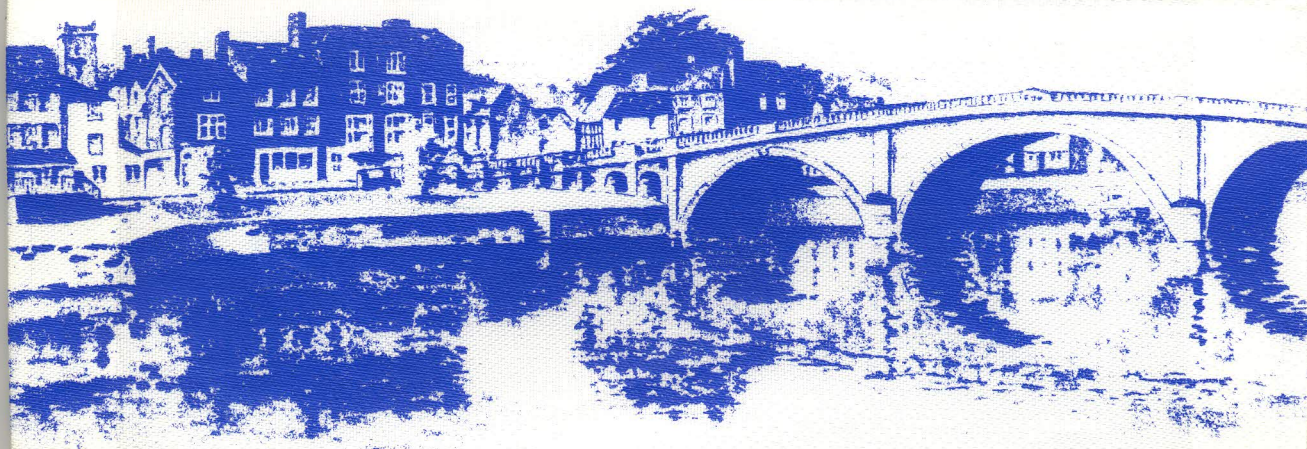


THE ROTARY CLUB OF BEWDLEY



Bewdley is an historic town on the banks of the River Severn, just over 20 miles west of Birmingham.

Until the coming of the canals and the railways, Bewdley was a major inland port and the timber-framed and Georgian buildings are visible evidence of its previous prosperity.

The present bridge over the River Severn was completed in 1798 under the direction of the famous engineer, Thomas Telford.
